Wider Curriculum

In **PE** we will learn games, object manipulation and gymnastics.

In **Green Learning** we will spend time getting to know the nature trail and the rules and routines of Green Schools. We will learn the parts of an oak tree.

We will use 'Tales Toolkit,' an oracy based resource that enhances children's speaking, listening and communication skills by allowing them to use their imagination and create their own stories.

We will use 'Now Press Play' an immersive storytelling resource, where the children become the main character in a story, meeting people, discovering places and solving problems, on an educational adventure they'll never forget.

We will use 'Letters and Sounds' a programme which helps to develop speaking and listening skills to make a good start for reading and writing.

In **Music** we will remember and sing entire songs. We will learn songs for our Christmas singalong and perform them to our grown-ups.

In **PSHE** the themes are: Being Me in My World: We will focus on how it feels to belong, understanding why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands, learning about responsibilities and that we all have a right to learn and play. Celebrating Difference: thinking about what makes us similar and different from each other, what makes us special, how to be a good friend and how to stand up for ourselves.

In RWE , we will celebrate Diwali, the festival of light. In History , we will discuss Bonfire Night. In PSHE , we will learn to stay safe near bonfires and fireworks.
Monday 11 th November	In English, we will learn a Nursery Rhyme a day as part of 'World Nursery Rhyme Week.'
