We will learn the parts of an oak tree.</p> <p>We will use '<b>Tales Toolkit</b>,' an oracy based resource that enhances children's speaking, listening and communication skills by allowing them to use their imagination and create their own stories.</p> |  |

We will use **'Now Press Play'** an immersive storytelling resource, where the children become the main character in a story, meeting people, discovering places and solving problems, on an educational adventure they'll never forget.

We will use **'Letters and Sounds'** a programme which helps to develop speaking and listening skills to make a good start for reading and writing.

In **Music** we will remember and sing entire songs. We will learn songs for our Christmas singalong and perform them to our grown-ups.

In **PSHE** the themes are: Being Me in My World: We will focus on how it feels to belong, understanding why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands, learning about responsibilities and that we all have a right to learn and play. Celebrating Difference: thinking about what makes us similar and different from each other, what makes us special, how to be a good friend and how to stand up for ourselves.
