Week beginning:	
Monday 9 th September	This week your child will attend for half days. We will introduce them to the rules and routines of the school day at Coldfall. They will enjoy story times, circle games and lots of time to play and get to know one another.
Monday 16 th September	<p>In English, we will explore the book 'Me and My Family Tree'. In Maths, we will match objects and pictures and identify a set. In Science, we will learn about the parts of the body In Phonics, we will learn the sounds first Set 1 Sounds: m,a,s,d</p> <p>Staff will begin to assess each child individually using the Government issued Baseline Assessment.</p>
Monday 23 rd September	<p>In English, we will enjoy the story of 'Bumblebear' In Maths, we will sort objects, explore sorting techniques and create sorting rules In Science, we will investigate the senses In Phonics, we will work on Set 1 sounds: t,i,n,p Staff will continue to assess each child individually using the Government issued Baseline Assessment.</p>
Monday 30 th September	<p>In English, will enjoy the story of 'The Cave' In Maths, we will compare size and mass In RE, we will help the children think about what makes them special In Phonics, we will work on Set 1 sounds: g,o,c,k</p>
Monday 7 th October <i>It's Good to be Me' Day and Perform Drama workshop: 11.10.24</i>	<p>In English, we will read the story 'Monkey Puzzle'. The children will begin writing in their English books. In Maths, we will compare capacity In History, the children will think about who is in their family and what job they would like when they are older. In Phonics, we will work on Set 1 sounds: u,b,f,e</p>
Monday 14 th October	<p>In English, we will look at non-fiction texts regarding looking after our teeth. In Maths, we will explore patterns In Computing, we will encourage computational thinking through the topics 'Look at how we grow' and 'movement algorithms'</p>
Monday 21 st October	<p>In English, we will share the rhyming book 'All the Ways to be Smart'. The children will think about what they are good at. In Maths, the children will create their own patterns. In RE, we will learn about the Harvest Festival In Phonics, we will carry out individual assessments with each child.</p>
Wider Curriculum	
<p>In Music, the children will be learning to listen to music and identify tempo and different instruments. They will perform songs and put movement to music. In PE lessons the children will learn how to use different size balls, rolling, bouncing, throwing, catching, practise negotiating spaces successfully when moving around a space, using different body parts to move to develop strength and listening and following specific game related instructions. In Green School, we will be getting to know the nature trail, having fun outside, and learning the rules and routines that keep us safe and happy outdoors. We will also learn the parts of an oak tree and how to identify one.</p>	

In **PSHE** the themes are:

Being Me in My World: We will focus on how it feels to belong, understanding why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands, learning about responsibilities and that we all have a right to learn and play.

Celebrating Difference: thinking about what makes us similar and different from each other, what makes us special, how to be a good friend and how to stand up for ourselves.

Monday 18 th November <i>Parents Evenings</i>	<p>In English we will read the story 'Sharing a Shell' and look at reading and writing invitations.</p> <p>In Maths, we will investigate circles and triangles.</p> <p>In Geography, we will learn about, read and draw maps.</p> <p>In Phonics, we will learn Set 1 sounds: th,z,ch,qu</p>
Monday 25 th November	<p>In English we will look at the Nativity story, retelling the story and acting it out.</p> <p>In Maths, we will look at the composition of numbers 1,2,3,4 and 5.</p> <p>In Art, we will learn about the artist Chris Ofili and create self portraits</p> <p>In Phonics, we will introduce Set 1 sounds: x,ng,nk</p>
Monday 2 nd December <i>Winter Fair</i>	<p>In English we will read the story 'Refuge' make links to the Nativity story</p> <p>In Maths, we will continue our investigation of 1,2,3,4,5</p> <p>In Design Technology, we will be baking gingerbread to sell at the Winter Fair.</p> <p>In Phonics, we will consolidate our knowledge of Set 1 sounds and Set 1 Key Words.</p>
Monday 9 th December <i>Reception Christmas show</i>	<p>In English we will read the Hanukkah story '8 Candles to Light'</p> <p>In Maths, we will investigate shapes with 4 sides.</p> <p>In History, we will explore teddies and toys throughout history.</p> <p>In Phonics, we will focus on memorising Key Words.</p>
Monday 16 th December <i>Christmas party</i>	<p>In English we will make and write in cards for family members.</p> <p>In Maths, we will consolidate key skills from the term.</p> <p>In PSHE, we will learn about Road Safety and Taking Care</p>
